Come enjoy a refreshing stroll through this picturesque garden for monarch butterflies and other pollinators, located at the north end of the Parkville Nature Sanctuary parking lot. The butterfly garden was established in 2017 to honor the memories of the former beloved Nature Sanctuary Director, Bob Fluchel.

The Garden features a botanical collection of over twenty different native plant species, hundreds of individual plants, and a chipped trail through the garden. The edging is composed of commemorative bricks from donors to the Sanctuary.
